

Combe Hill Wood

is situated about 3 miles south-east of Street, Somerset, above & between the nearby Villages of Compton Dundon & Butleigh. Accessible via the ridge road known as Reynald's Way which links the B3151 and the B3153 and has a spacious car park. Grid ref ST 503 331

From this point there are views over Compton Dundon village, Dundon Beacon & Lollover Hill, Ham Hill (middle distance) and the Quantock Hills (far distance).



This carved wooden seat is just at the top of the above viewpoint. You can sit here and admire that view!



62 ACRES OF BEAUTIFUL WOODLAND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

The wood occupies an area of 62 acres, or about 25 hectares. It's depth is about 1/2 mile from north to south, while it's width is just a little more than 1/2 mile from east to west.




One of many attractive twists & turns along the specially laid stoned pathways of the wood.
