



WALKING

Walk 2 - Old Oaks circular via Paddington Farm, Maiden Croft Lane, Bulwarks Ln, Wellhouse Ln, Tor & Stone Down Lane - 2.8 miles

- Using the footpath between The Walnut Terraces and The Birches, walk to the top.
- Through the kissing gate and turn right. Pass the ancient Oaks - Gog & Magog on your right.
- Bear right and pass through the gate. Horses will often be spotted in the field to your right.
- After passing through the next gate, walk diagonally across this field to the opposite corner.
- Over the stile and across a small bridge and over the next stile.
- At the brow of this hill, cross the field to the next stile and cross. You are now at Paddington Farm Trust.
- Follow the lane round to the left, past the 'World's smallest farm shop' and up through the farmyard.
- Continue on this lane (Maiden Croft) for approx. 500m. Turn right at junction.
- Next Y junction turn left onto Bulwarks Lane. Stay on this road which merges into Lypyat Lane.
- At T junction, turn right down Wellhouse Lane.
- If you're thirsty, you can drink from the White Spring on your left or the Red Spring on your right towards the bottom of the lane.
- Before reaching the end of Wellhouse Lane, take the footpath on the left (just past Berachah Guest House). This wooded path takes you to the foot of Glastonbury Tor.
- Follow the path to the top. Enjoy the spectacular views.
- Begin your descent by using the steps on the other side of the Tor.
- At the bottom, pass through the kissing gate. Take the concrete path. Pass through another gate.
- You are now on Stone Down Lane. Turn right.
- Just past the Tor Bus Stop (runs between Glastonbury & Tor every 30 mins April to Sept), turn left.
- Continue down Stone Down Lane for approx. 750m. At metal gate on left go through kissing gate.
- In approx. 200m turn right through kissing gate and down the lane. Home.
